

## FORM B – Declaration of Criminal Record

Applicants should not declare a conviction for which the applicant has received:

- A Pardon in accordance with the Criminal Records Act
- A conviction where the Applicant was a “young person” under the Youth Criminal Justice Act
- An absolute or conditional discharge pursuant to section 730 of the Criminal Code
- An Offence for which the Applicant was not convicted
- Any provincial or municipal offence
- Any charges dealt with outside of Canada.

Declaration of Criminal Record does not constitute a Certified Criminal Record by the RCMP.

Declaration of Criminal Record may not contain all criminal record convictions. A certified Criminal Record can only be issued by CCRTIS based on the submission of fingerprints to the RCMP National Repository of Criminal Records.
